This year's convention offers a full schedule. You will find many familiar events, like scenic drives and gimmick rallies, as well as some new events. In addition, autocross on a converted WWII airfield and a planned Concours plus antique airplane fly-in are just a few of the interesting points of this convention. Perrin Air Force base Museum is very close by, it was used in World War II as a pilot testing station and sort of a "guinea Pig" for many new ideas that were adopted by the US Air Force. The Hagerman National Wildlife refuge is located just south of The hotel and offers great views of migratory shorebirds and White Pelicans during October.
